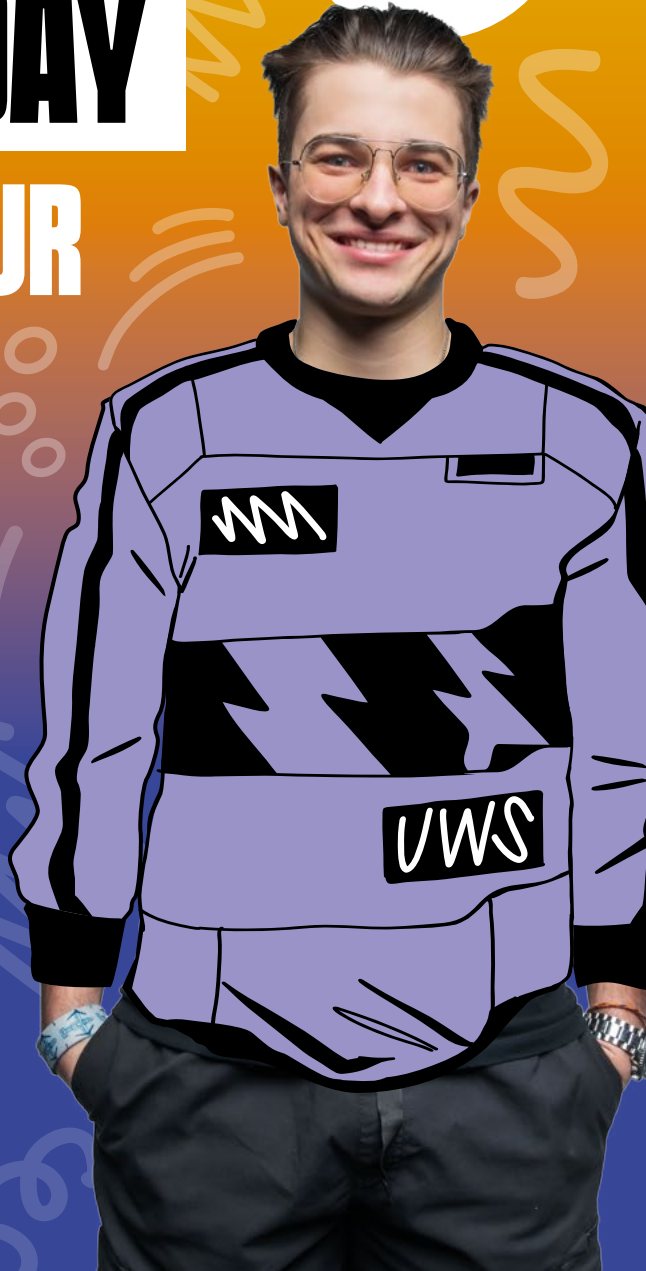

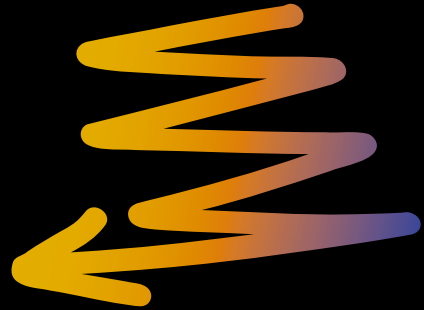
**We're delighted that you're joining us for this event! It is a great chance for you to find out about #LifeAtUWS as you consider your next move.**

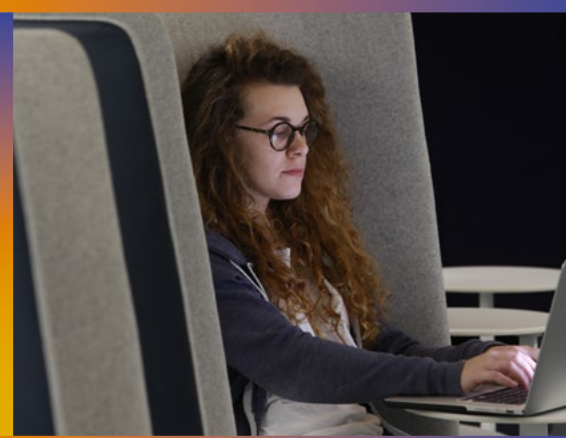

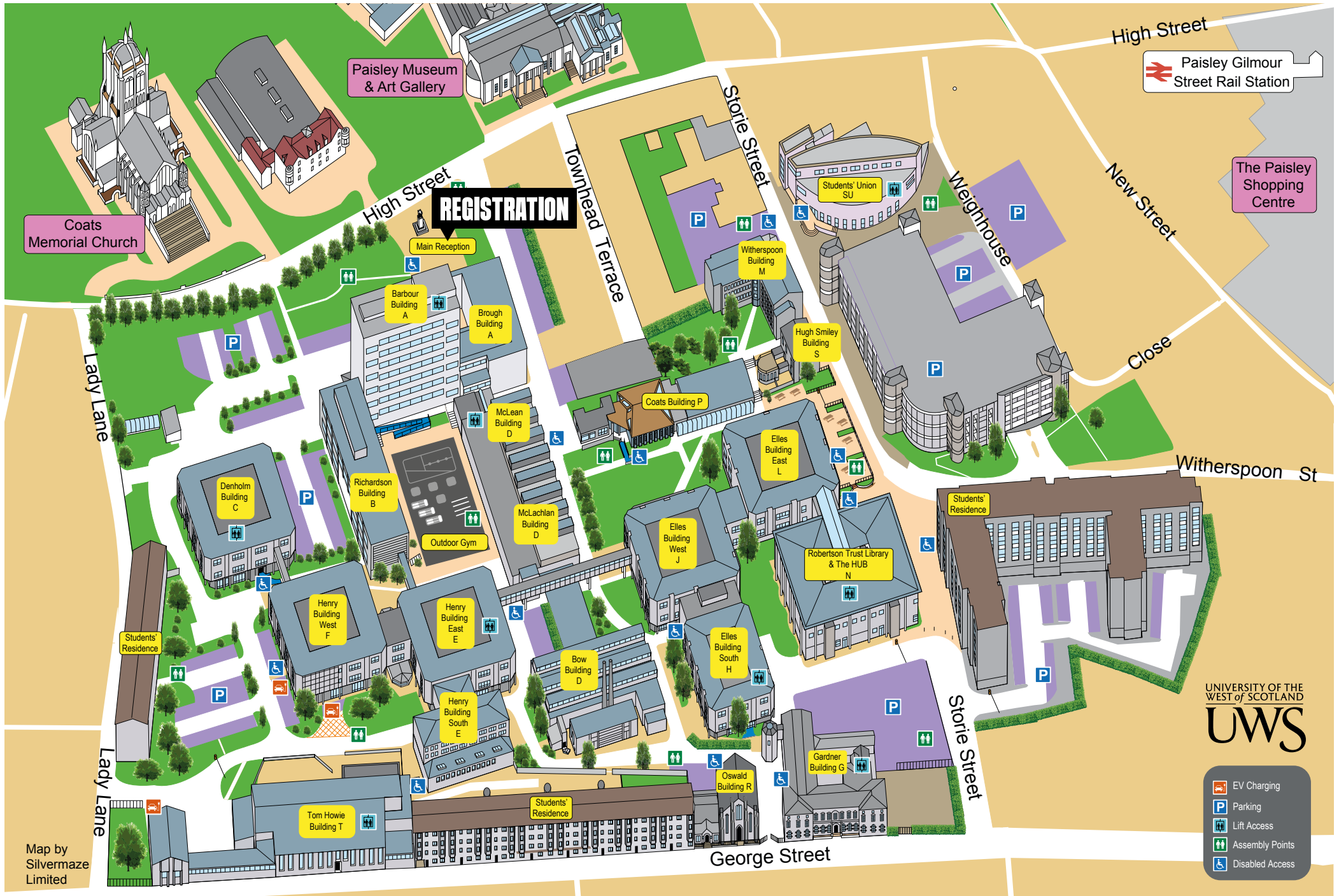
