Since the pilot of the UWS Foundation Academy in 2022, we have engaged with over 2500 senior pupils across more than 30 schools in Ayrshire, Renfrewshire, Lanarkshire, Argyll & Bute, Dumfries & Galloway, and Glasgow City. The UWS Foundation Academy continues to expand and is offered to target schools across the West of Scotland.

## UWS WIDENING ACCESS TO HIGHER EDUCATION

UWS is widely recognised as one of Scotland's leading universities in widening participation in higher education and underpinning the UWS Foundation Academy is the principle that Higher Education should be available to all. The innovative programme aims to raise both aspirations and awareness of Higher Education opportunities available to pupils within their local community and at UWS we aim to encourage and support all applicants, regardless of background or circumstance.

### **HOW DOES IT WORK?**

The UWS Foundation Academy programme involves a blended approach, starting with a university campus visit, followed by schoolbased and online learning, allowing senior pupils to study at university level and gain a qualification certificate worth 20 credits at SCQF level 7.

Pupils are given the chance to experience the university environment first hand, explore different study options, and develop the key academic skills needed to succeed at university.

Pupils are invited to register interest via their school, during their S5 year, with an aim to complete the programme by the December of their S6 year.

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## WHO CAN TAKE PART?

The UWS Foundation Academy programme is offered to senior pupils who are interested in applying to university from high school and may need some guidance with study pathways, support with the application process, or their qualifications may fall slightly short of the typical entry requirements.

Schools are asked to register pupils who they feel would benefit most from taking part in the programme.

## **WHY TAKE PART?**

The UWS Foundation Academy is a great way for senior pupils to:

- Discover a range of university pathways
- Develop academic skills at university level
- Improve the quality of their university application
- Become familiar with the university environment
- Build on skills and confidence before moving on from school
- Access a range of UWS benefits, including 1 to 1 guidance and support on study options

For eligible degree programmes at UWS, successful completion of the UWS Foundation Academy will also adjust pupils' offer of entry, used as an alternative to 1 Higher at B on standard entry requirements. A list of all degree programmes and those eligible for adjusted entry requirements can be found inside this leaflet.

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No matter the programme or university choices pupils make, studying on the UWS Foundation Academy programme shows a commitment to developing skills and allows pupils to gain a valuable insight into studying at university – which could enhance pupils' overall UCAS application and CV.
